Casual Bookings: can be made via email or telephone. These can be made up to 7 days in advance and cancelled without charge with 48 hours notice. If you do not provide 48 hours notice for a cancellation this is charged as an absence.

Fee Payments: GBOOSH is working towards streamlining payments via Direct Debit for all families. Please contact the centre if you require a Direct Debit form to sign up for this service.

Safety when entering from June Place: please remember that when entering the school grounds from June Place there are a number of safety issues to consider.

- ✓ Park carefully- parking officers have been known to issue tickets for parking illegally in June Place. Cars have also been hit by other cars particularly if they are not right off the road. Also watch for pedestrians and driveways.
- Respect the residents of June Place do not block driveways, be mindful of gardens and private property.
- ✓ Please shut AND LATCH gate 1 & 2 this keeps children in & unknown visitors out. Please do not let any children pass through the gate without an adult accompanying them.
- ✓ Watch your step there are children running, playing with sports equipment & a narrow pathway. Please see the Responible Person on Duty if you identify a hazard or safety concern.
- ✓ Advise centre staff if your child needs to be sent up from the hall. Under Department COVID restrictions GBOOSH is not allowed to have parents moving around school grounds.

Medical Conditions and Risk Plans

Child care Regulations and NQS

During the annual enrolment process we ask all families of children with a diagnosed medical condition, allergy or asthma to submit a copy of their child's medical action plan. These plans MUST be signed off by the child's GP and should be no more than 12 months old. These plans are used to inform all Educators of how to manage a child's illness, allergy or medical condition.





Shortly Skye Hunt (Joint Coordinator) will be contacting these families to request the completion of a Risk Minimisation Plan. This plan assists GBOOSH to identify risks associated with any medical conditions so we can look at ways to minimize exposure, manage the condition, emergency contacts and also where any medication will be stored. These plans are all requirements of our licensing, CCS and the National Quality Standard so it is important that families return these each year. GBOOSH can be penalised if this information is not completed correctly, this is why we can not take bookings or enrolments without this information.

As we are a separate entity to the school please do not assume that the school will provide us with copies of updated plans. Parents can update these via email, in person or the QK Enrol Family Lounge.
